

Mt. Haguro excursion!

Haguro



Mt. Haguro is one of the three sacred mountains of Dewa. At 414 meters tall, this mountain is accessible all year round by car or on foot. From its base, there is a total of 2446 stone steps leading to the peak. During your travel on the stone steps, you will encounter a designated

National Treasure, the five-storied pagoda. If you are especially attentive, you may be able to spot the 33 carvings in the stone steps. It is said, that if you can spot all 33, your wish will come true. With over 1400 years of history as a mountain of Shugen, Mt. Haguro is considered a power spot by many.

The Kamo Aquarium experience!

The aquarium doubles as a research facility and boasts the largest number of jellyfish on display in the world. Some of the most popular spots in the aquarium are the gigantic jelly fish tank named "Jellyfish Dream Theater" and the cafe where guests can try jellyfish ice cream and ramen. Shonai region's local fish species are also on display. Come see, feel, learn, and discover at Kamo Aquarium.
